

## Scene Study

5 x 2hr, or 6 x 1hr40, classes run via Zoom, £70.

These classes are being run in a course format for ease of booking, but are scene study classes in the US style. Scenes will be allocated in advance of class, and scene partners are encouraged to meet (likely virtually) to discuss and rehearse their scene in advance of class time, although this is not required. Each class will involve the presentation and redirection of scenes. Each scene will be allocated at least two hours of focused work over the duration of the course. As with the US model, participants will also observe one another's scenes, and will learn from the choices, techniques, and approaches taken with others as well.

Scene study classes will suit Advanced students and professional actors.

Scene Study class provides an opportunity to:

Experiment with different techniques and choices in a safe space

Challenge yourself to probe the depths of text and character

Keep your acting instincts sharp

Build your knowledge base of playwrights and texts

Each class will involve

A brief physical and vocal warmup and cooldown

The presentation of two scenes

Observation work on scenes presented

Detailed redirection on each of the scenes

Individual work outside of class time, including line learning and redirection homework

You will need

Zoom installed on your laptop

Somewhere private to work during our classes

Approximately 1m square in front of your laptop to work in

This will be an interactive, participatory class: your camera and mic will both need to be switched on.

A reasonable level of English is also required.
